1. Attend an agency orientation held at CASA every Thursday from 12:00-1:00 pm

3. Complete interview with the Deputy Director (bring application)
4. Begin your background check (\$35 fee payable to CASA of Jackson County)
5. Attend approximate 30 hours of classroom training (schedule below), complete required preclass reading and five hours of court observation.
