There is now wildfire housing relief for homeowners offered by Oregon Housing and Community Services (OHCS).

AVAILABLE EMERGENCY SHELTER/PARKING IN MEDFORD: The following are emergency parking and shelter areas available in Medford for families and individuals who have lost their homes or have been evacuated.

First Presbyterian Church at 85 S. Holly is offering emergency shelter for up to 25 individuals within families that have been displaced from their homes. Food and bedding will be provided and COVID-19 health and safety measures will be followed. With limited space available, please contact Pastor Murray Richmond at 907-347-3365 to check availability.

The New Life Church of the Nazarene, 1974 East McAndrews Road, is offering their parking lot with approximately 200 spaces available for vehicles and RVs. With limited space available, please call 541-779-7777 to check availability. Restrooms will be available. Vehicles will only be allowed every third space. *Also an official City of Medford shelter, beds are first come first serve, call for a space.

North Medford High School, 1900 N. Keene Way Drive, parking lot and gym will be open at 6:30 p.m. tonight (September 9). Restrooms and showers are available. Looking to help? Our community partners are working hard to open additional sites that will need volunteers and other essential supplies.

The United Church of Christ in Ashland (near the Safeway) is open during the day for folks who need a place for internet access, bathrooms and phone service.

The Salvation Army Emergency Disaster Service team has been activated in Jackson County.

- The Salvation Army HOPE House transitional shelter program site in Medford is now operating as an Evacuee Shelter while still housing program participants. We are currently housing 31 evacuees and have the capacity for 50 evacuees. Meals are being provided for evacuees at the shelter. If you need assistance please call 541-773-6965 x101.
- We are providing food boxes and clothing vouchers.
- Thrift Store is closed today (9/9). The Thrift Store will open tomorrow (9/10) for evacuees to redeem clothing vouchers.



EMERGENCY 1X

RVTD has a special emergency service Route 1X between Medford and Ashland beginning Thursday September 10th. The Route will travel from Medford using Exit 27 to Ashland using Exit 19, traveling south through Ashland serving limited stops, and then using Exit 14 to return to Medford. the 1x only serves four stops within Ashland.

The Emergency 1X will leave Front Street Station hourly beginning at 7:00AM until 6:00PM on Thursday, Friday and Saturday (Sept. 10-12). All RVTD fare types will be accepted on this special 1X route. Due to the congestion being experienced on I-5 we are unable to provide a schedule within Ashland however buses should be expected between :20 to :35 after each hour at 1x stops.
