Joe also volunteers as a Peer Coach, helping newly trained CASA volunteers navigate their first cases. He is there to answer questions, address concerns and work toward positive solutions. His heart is dedicated to CASA, to children and to his community.



Recently, Joe bestowed a great honor on our organization by naming CASA as a beneficiary of his annuities. It is especially humbling when someone who is doing the work as a volunteer, also wishes to support CASA financially. During a planning meeting, Joe called CASA his “family”. He said for a long while, he felt that he was not making a difference for the youth he was advocating for, despite our staff and other CASAs telling him otherwise. One day, after his youth had moved to a relative placement out of county, they reunited and met for lunch. His youth expressed to him the difference he had made in his life. This youth had been depressed, felt abandoned and unloved. He explained that when CASA Joe showed up in his life, he felt valued again and regained the hope that had been lost for so long. Joe wiped away tears as he shared this heartwarming story, a story that was confirmation of what we, at CASA, already knew in our hearts.

Joe’s act of generosity, not only with his heart and time, but also his financial support, inspired us to create a Legacy Society, in which to honor people who include CASA in their giving plans. Our work is dependent upon community support. Together, we can continue forward, holding the hands of children as they discover their own resilience and renewed hope.
